



# DRESS CODE FOR STUDENTS

## INTRODUCTION

The School Council has established a Dress Code for all students attending this school. By enrolling your child/children in our school you are entering into an agreement to abide by the policy that governs the uniform of East Beechboro Primary School on the guidelines set down by the Education Department of WA.

## BELIEFS

The School Council believes in a School Dress Code:

- Fosters and enhances the public image of the school;
- Assists in building school and team spirit;
- Ensures students are safely dressed for specific school activities;
- Encourages equity among students;
- Instills pride in personal presentation;
- Prepares students for work where dress codes are required.

## DRESS CODE REQUIREMENTS FOR EAST BEECHBORO PRIMARY SCHOOL

### Summer Uniform

Maroon Skirt  
Maroon Skorts  
Maroon Airflow Shorts – unisex  
Maroon Unisex shorts  
Checkered dress  
Blue Polo shirt with collar  
Blue surf shirt without collar but crew neck  
Blue long sleeve sun smart polo shirt with collar  
SunSmart hat (broad brimmed/legionaires)  
Appropriate Shoes and or Sandals

### Sports Carnival Uniform

A selection of faction colours in:  
Polo shirt with collar.  
Surf shirt without collar but crew neck.  
Pants as in uniform above.  
Hat as in uniform above.

### Winter Uniform

Maroon fleece tracksuit pant  
Maroon Cargo pant  
Jazz pant  
Maroon fleece Zip Jacket  
Maroon fleece Windcheater  
Blue polo shirt with collar  
Blue surf shirt without collar but crew neck  
Blue long sleeve sun smart polo shirt with collar  
Maroon Fleece Scarf (not permitted in classroom)  
Maroon Beanie (not permitted in class room)

### Students moving to High School

Students may wear the specially designed School Leavers Shirt.

## HEALTH AND SAFETY

The School Council has established a Dress Code for all students attending this school. By enrolling your child/children in our school you are entering into an agreement to abide by the policy that governs the uniform of East Beechboro Primary School on the guidelines set down by the Education Department of WA.

- Students should ensure that they take appropriate protection from the sun when outdoors. They are encouraged to wear hats all year round. Visors, beanies and baseball hats do not provide appropriate cover and are not to be worn in place of a hat.

### **NO HAT (SUNSMART) = NO PLAY**

- Students who do not wear a hat will be restricted to the covered areas during recess and lunch breaks. During sports sessions students without hats will be given a blue hat to wear.
- Appropriate footwear is to be worn. No thongs or scuffs.
- Jewellery – for safety reasons children may only wear small sleepers or studs in ears and a watch.
- The Education Department Regulations state that hair longer than shoulder length should be tied back with a plain scrunchie or hair elastic.

## **INAPPROPRIATE DRESS**

1. Denim is NOT permitted.
2. All cosmetics are inappropriate at school.
3. Brand name clothing is NOT acceptable.

## **ADVICE TO STUDENTS AND PARENTS ON DRESS CODE**

Please ensure all items of clothing, shoes and personal items are clearly marked with your child's name, preferably with permanent marker.

## **MODIFICATIONS TO THE DRESS CODE**

Students who for religious or health reasons, may wish to modify the school dress code are required to make an Appointment with the principal to discuss such modifications. Staff will be informed of any student granted a modification to the dress code.

## **NON COMPLIANCE**

The following will occur for students not following the dress code:

- Encouragement to wear the uniform
- Assistance/support in obtaining suitable clothing, if necessary.
- Parents may be contacted.
- The school may provide substitute clothing for the day.

Students not following the dress code without written explanation by their Parent or Guardian, may be denied the opportunity to represent the school at official school activities which include excursions, sporting and social events.

## **FINANCIAL DIFFICULTIES**

Students whose families experience financial difficulties regarding the purchase of a uniform should contact the principal to discuss the situation.
